Countywide Points of Interest Pedestrian Plan (PIPP) & Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Stakeholder Meetings



SANBAG is developing a Countywide Points of Interest Pedestrian Plan (PIPP) to assist member agencies with the development of plans and tools for identifying and prioritizing pedestrian improvements in the region. The PIPP aims to utilize analytical tools and work with member jurisdictions to identify 25 non-ranked pedestrian points of interest locations throughout the County (one for each member jurisdiction) for which the SANBAG consultant team will conduct bicycle and pedestrian counts and prepare a detailed improvement plan. The tools and plans generated through this project will be added to SANBAG's Non-Motorized Transportation Plan. **Please contact Miguel Núñez if you plan to attend the meeting and would like to reserve a time for follow-up discussion.**
